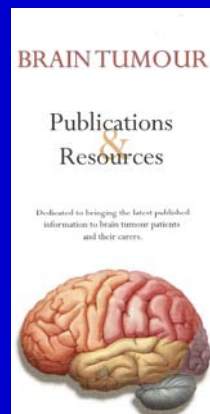

- hope

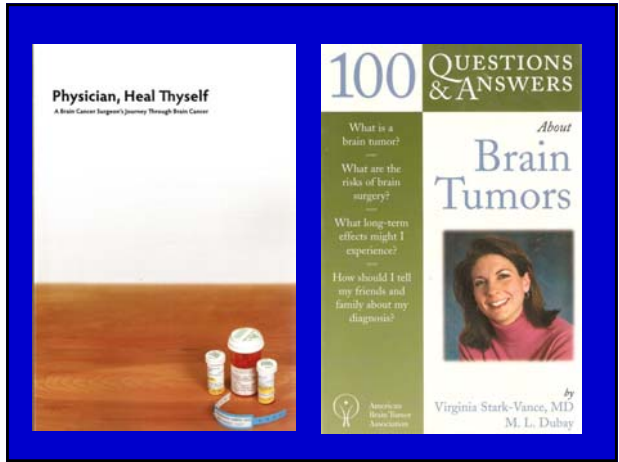
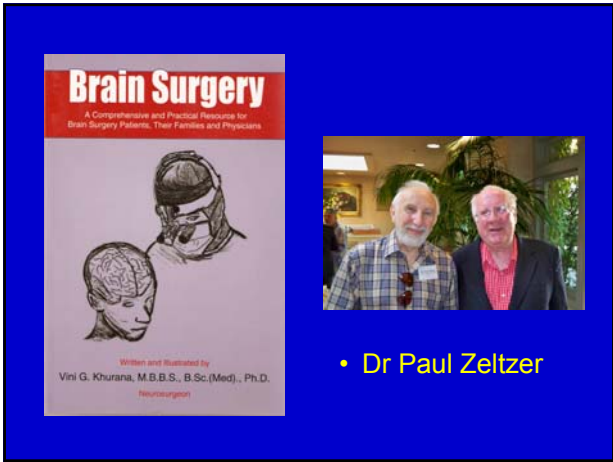
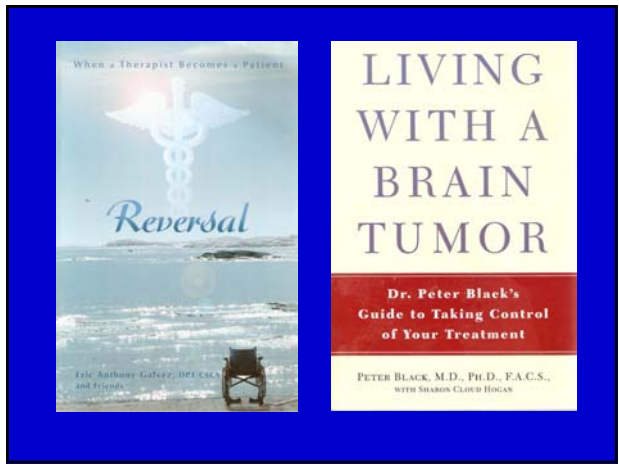
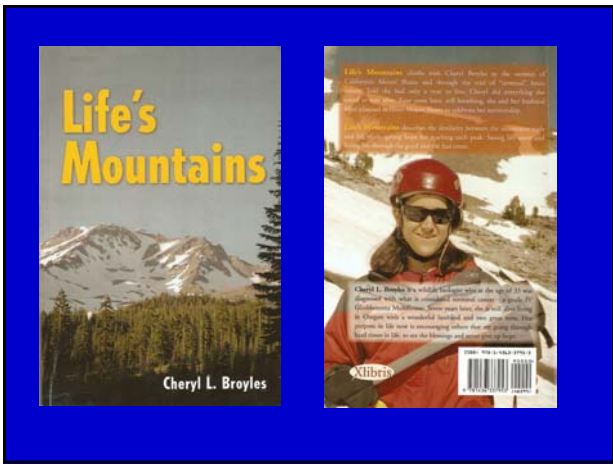
